Meadow View Neighborhood Watch

The Meadow View Board of Directors is recommending that a Neighborhood Watch group could help in reducing unwanted activities in our community. Such a group would consist of resident volunteers that are concerned about security and safety within Meadow View. The group would not be involved in policing, but strictly dedicated to swift communications regarding any incidents that threaten Meadow View residents or their property.

Several years ago a Watch group was formed and was in liaison with the Jefferson County Sheriff. However, due to attrition and changes in personnel, the liaison has lapsed. To support renewed safety, we have re-established this liaison and plan to make a strong effort to improve the security in our area.

Based on this premise, volunteer Watch Members are needed to create a security force that will help raise the risk factor for any criminals or mischief makers who might consider taking advantage of a lax community.

The MV-Watch program will be available on a 24/7 schedule. Examples of incidents that might be reported are:

- Fire or Smoke nearby
- Missing child or pet
- Suspicious activity
- Vandalism
- Criminal Activity

The communications system is completely PRIVATE and will be available to Watch Members only. The system is NOT to be used for social, HOA, business, ads, complaints, or any non-security related communications. So I expect that communications will rarely occur and will be relevant to our safety and security. The idea is to get an ALERT out as soon as possible to maximize the number of residents that can possibly take action.

To volunteer, you must meet these requirements:

- Currently residing in Meadow View
- Have a cell phone in your name
- Be able to receive text messages
- Have notifications turned on 24/7
- Be able to report as an observer
